for artists to the Shopper and InterTown Record. She will also contact Katy Brown who is head of an artists group in Concord. Laura will contact Mary Morris to see if she has any artists contacts that we could send the information to. We also need to assemble a jury. Caroline had some people in mind.

We will do an ad in the Concord Monitor which will include the \$200 sponsors' logos. We'll also put their logos on the posters.
